What You Get to Do:

Provide meals to campers, visitors, and employees in a friendly manner with attention to quality customer service while ensuring all safety and sanitary regulations are followed

Set up serving lines, counters, salad bars, beverages, and hot wells for all meals
Support of Melody Freeze and Catering Food Venues as well.
Positions may include split shifts starting at 6 a.m. and end by 10 p.m. with scheduled 8 hour work days.
Keep the dining area neat, clean, and orderly at all times throughout and in between the meal periods
Serve the customers in a friendly and efficient manner. Keep the salad bar area fully stocked and cleaned
Be familiar with what ingredients are in the food that is being offered, identifying if there are dairy or nuts in the food being served
Work in the dish room to clean pots, pans, dishes, utensils and run the dishwasher.
Be comfortable using equipment including serving utensils, carts, and hand wash buckets

Housing will be determined by the completion of the Housing Agreement Form. Housing will be on campus, just a short walk from the main area. Each unit is furnished with (2) twin beds and a shared bathroom. Housing may be in nature cabins in a wooded area or in dorm type buildings, depending on availability and costs \$18/night. This also includes 3 meals a day during dining hall hours and the rental of a cell phone with internet/wifi service. Interlochen will provide bedding which includes sheets, a blanket, a pillow and pillow case and two towels. Students may use the Fitness Center, outdoor courts and beach front areas.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

Work & Travel participants are welcome to arrive via plane, bus, or car to Interlochen Arts Camps. Students are to arrive Sunday through Tuesday of their start week. All students will begin working at Interlochen Center for the Arts on a Wednesday, with a Welcome Orientation.

Our Transportation Team will pick students up at the Bus Station in Traverse City or at Cherry Capital Airport in Traverse City. Once students know their travel plans, students can click on a Transportation Link to schedule our Transportation team to pick them up at either the Traverse City bus station or airport and then shortly arrive at Interlochen's campus to check in. The ride from the airport to Interlochen's campus is about 25 minutes. We are only able to offer pick up service at the bus station or airport in Traverse City. Ideally, Work & Travel participants will send their travel itinerary to our Transportation Team no later than early April.

We will instruct students how to apply and visit the local Social Security office if necessary at the start of summer. A small grocery market, Tom's, is a short walk away or just one bus stop north.

TRAINING AND ONBOARDING
